

SCHOOL ANNUAL REPORT 2017-18

Namaskar,

It gives me immense pride to present the annual report of the school. With every passing year, I feel there is more and more added to the reports of the school's achievements. But because of paucity of time, I would deem it fit to highlight only the important aspects of the school's progress.

ACADEMICS

Our Board results improve every year and again this year, the school students in both 10th and 12th did us proud by scoring very high percentages. 153 out of 242 students got distinctions i.e. above 80%. 65 students secured a first division and 24 students got a second division in class 10. 24 students secured 10 on 10 CGPA which is equivalent to 95%

The 12th Board results are as follows:

All the 33 students of the science stream secured a 1st division with Ms.Purvi Singh Verma and Mst. Parth Gupta securing 94.6 percent.

The results of this batch of commerce stream were exceptional with 43 students obtaining distinction and 34 with first divisions and 8 students with second division of a batch of 88 students. Ms. Mallika Sikarwar did us proud with a 95.4% result. The Humanities stream did the school proud by producing the state topper in the form of Ms.Palak Ahuja with 98.4%. 11 students secured distinctions and 7 students secured first division of a batch of 19.

Year 2017 has been a harbinger of Excellence in the school.

The **Students and Teachers Quality Circles** participated in the **National Convention of Quality Circles held at Mysuru** with case study and won 5 Excellence Awards and 1 Distinguished award amidst 700 case studies and 110 elite companies participating.

At the National Convention of School Quality Control Circles held at Delhi, the team bagged 1st Prize in Case Study Presentation and 2nd Prize in Nukkad Natak and Collage Making.

The School was awarded with the **Best District Principal Award** by the **Science Olympiad Foundation for the second time**. The school was awarded on the basis of maximum students participating in the Olympiads successfully and securing high ranks at the national and international levels.

The Principal was nominated for the National Award for Teachers 2017 instituted by MHRD by the CBSE and was shortlisted from the Ajmer region for the award.

A 6 member team of participants brought home the **Championship trophy from Reflections, an International Festival for History and Civics at CMS, Lucknow**. The team more or less bagged prizes in every event they participated in.

In competitions organized on 12th International Innovations Day by CMS, Lucknow, Glorian has bagged Special Mention Award in Essay Writing and 2nd Prize in Calligraphy.

At the INTACH Inter School competitions, Glorians bagged 2nd Position in Heritage Anthem, 1st position in Painting and Essay Writing Competition, 1st Position in Folk Group Dance Competition, 3rd Position in City Level Quiz Competition.

Glorian Pragya Bansal bagged 1st Position in Junior Category and Dhruv Agarwal got 2nd Position in Senior Category in the country in the Heritage Olympiad. Articles by Glorians are regularly published in the INTACH newsletter.

Deepanshi Gupta of Class 7 emerged as Regional Winner of My City, My Heritage Competition by INTACH amongst 17000 participants all over India.

Dhruv Agarwal won the Young INTACH Best Heritage Club Student Award.

The School Heritage Club wins the 3rd Best Heritage Club in the country by INTACH.

In the International Young Film Makers Festival by Expressions India, the school won the Outstanding Film Award for a film on bullying 'I am Me' at Delhi.

The school won the Best Sound Editing Award in the Inter School Documentary Film Making Competition Dai Miraaz.

The school delegation participated in the 1st School SPICMACAY International Convention in Bangalore.

Senior Under Officer, Tanushka Tripathi represented MP & CG Dte at Delhi on Republic Day and got selected for Central Cultural Programme at PM House.

In the Katha Utsav, a creative event conducted by Katha Club that promotes creative writing among children, 7 students participated in the Regional level in Vadodara and 4 got selected for the National Workshop held in Gurugram.

In the Mitsubishi Asian Children's Enikki Festa by Confederation of UNESCO Clubs and Association of India two students received local organizers award.

Sanidhya Bhatia was selected to participate in the National Financial Literacy Assessment Test conducted by National Centre for Financial Education in second level in Mumbai and was acknowledged for Commendable Performance.

The Glorian team bagged the Best Delegate award, Verbal Mention, Special Mention, High Commendation and Best Delegation Trophy at the Indian International Model United Nations Inter School Event.

The School team won the High Commendation, Verbal Mention, Special Mention, Best Photographer, Best Cartoonist and Best Reporter Award at LAMUN held in Gwalior.

The school teams of Junior and Senior Category participated in the State Level Exhibition of the Children's Science Congress at Dewas. The Senior team participated at the 25th National Science Congress at Science City, Ahmedabad. A paper on Perpetual Light – a boon for the farmers was presented in this Congress by Glorian Pratha Gupta. She is acknowledged with the title of Child Scientist.

The school won the 2nd Position at the DRDE Science Exhibition held in their campus.

The school team participated at the CBSE Regional Level Science Exhibition held at Indore. The project was titled 'Faraday's cage' based on concept to promote electromagnetic shielding in certain portions of house like bedrooms and nurseries.
