- Regularity & punctuality – Attendance 75% - Neatness – Uniform (Overall).
- General Personality – Spoken English, Behaviour, Obedience, Co-operation towards classmates, teachers and school in general.
- Students who have been elected as a member of students council once, will not be allowed to contest the elections. This will help to provide equal opportunity to all the students.

TIPS FOR STUDENTS

1. **Pack your bag** according to the **time-table** the previous night, to come to the school.
Shoes to be **polished** and **uniform** to be **ironed** and hung the previous night.
2. Don't **procrastinate studies**. Start **preparations** from **day one**.
3. **Converse** in **English** at all times.

6. Kindly **label** the **belongings** of your **child** to avoid inconvenience.
7. Parents to read the **diary** carefully before **calling** school for any **clarification**. Please **follow all the rules** and **regulations** mentioned in it.
8. Mothers make sure you **pack** sumptuous **lunch** for your child **according** to the **lunch menu** along with **chopped fruits** to eat after **P. D. A.** period or in the **bus**. Place a **napkin** along with the **tiffin**.

KINDLY NOTE-

1. **G.K.** for all the classes and **Sanskrit/French** for class 5th will not have **Terminal Examinations**. It will be evaluated regularly through **Class Tests**.
2. **No term exam** will be held for **computer** also, it will be evaluated through **practicals** and **class performance**.
3. **Art and craft** will be evaluated through the **class performance**, no term examination will be held.
