

# General Information



- Students of classes IX to XII are eligible to participate.
- Each school is required to send a team of 3 students along with 1 teacher in-charge. The team must be present during the entire event at the venue.
- Participants must inform the organizing committee of the State selected by the team to display the Fabric on which the team will be making the documentary by 12<sup>th</sup> October 2024.
- Team members are requested to attend the event in the attire of the respective selected state.
- On the day of the event the participating teams must report at the venue by 8:30 am along with hard-copy of the Participation Form duly filled and signed by the Principal.
- Students are required to carry their ID cards endorsed by the Principal.
- The participating schools should mail their duly filled Participation Form at daimiraaz.gghs@gmail.com latest by 4<sup>th</sup> November 2024.

#### **GUIDELINES**

## 1. Theme Interpretation

- The inter-school documentary film-making competition aims to celebrate the traditional weaving legacy, capturing the fascinating journey of thread to fabric that defines India's rich textile heritage.
- The movie must explore the textile heritage of a chosen Indian state, showcasing its fabrics, weaving traditions, and cultural significance.
- Participants should choose one Indian state and focus their documentary on the fabrics of that state (number of fabrics may vary and entirely depends on the team) including historical, cultural, and artisanal aspects.

## 2. Content Requirements

- Participants must select one state from India and focus on the heritage of its fabric.
- The movie should be between 5-7 minutes in duration, including credits. Entries exceeding the time limit are liable to negative marking.
- The content should cover the history, cultural significance, and craftsmanship of fabrics from the selected state.
- It is suggested to include footage of interviews with artisans / vendors, textile production, and close- ups of fabrics in the film. Content can be taken from the internet with proper credits.

#### 3. Format & Submission

- The movie must be submitted in a high-resolution format such as MP4, MOV, or AVI.
- Ensure the final film file size is not more than 1 GB for easy submission.
- Submissions should be made digitally via a specified platform or email, with proper naming conventions (e.g. FilmTitle\_SchoolName) on the E-mail id daimiraaz.gghs@gmail.com by 12<sup>th</sup> Nov. 2024.
  - Synopsis
  - ▶ One Poster of the film in JPEG format of dimension 16:9.
  - ▶ Upload the documentary film on google drive and share the link via e-mail.
  - ► Crew and Cast List and Acknowledgement letter duly signed by the Principal (as per format enclosed-Annexure 1).
- Films can be in Hindi, English, or any regional language, but must include **English subtitles** if not in English.

#### 4. Disqualification or Negative Marking

- Entries with offensive or inappropriate content will not be entertained. Shooting of the documentary film should not be done by professionals or any other agency.
- School name / logo should not be mentioned anywhere in the documentary film in any form-audio / visual.

# 5. The event will be conducted in 3 phases and following will be the judgement criteria

I. Screening - Loomed Visuals: A Film Showcase of Indian Textiles

- iii. Cinematography & Visual Appeal
- iv. Technical Execution
- v. Effective Social Message
- vi. Overall Impact
- ii. Interlocution Textile Talks: Unraveling India's Fabric Legacy
  (All the team members will have to face the questions by panel judges about the film.)

- i. Depth of Knowledge Content and Technical
- ii. Clarity of Explanation
- iii. Engagement
- iv. Presentation Skills
- iii. Runway Rangrez: The Indian Fashion Showcase
  (All the participants will have to walk on the ramp in the traditional attire from the state chosen on which the documentary film has been made)

- iii. Overall Aesthetic Appeal
