

### Eligibility Criteria for Contesting Election –

- Studied 3 – 4 years in school.
- Academics – Above 85% for classes IX and X, Above 75% for class XI.
- Co-curricular Activities – Participation in atleast one School Competition / Inter School Competition– Cultural / Literary / Sports (Internal / External).
- Regularity & Punctuality – Attendance 75%.
- **General Personality** – Spoken English, Behaviour, Obedience, Cooperation towards classmates, teachers and school in general.
- New students are not allowed to contest the election as they need to understand the school system.
- Students who have been elected as a member of Students' Council once are not allowed to contest the election. This will provide equal opportunity to all the students.

## DETAILS OF SUMMER UNIFORM

### REGULAR UNIFORM

1. Grey striped trousers for girls and boys
2. Half sleeves pin stripe blue shirt (with school mono on the pocket) for boys.
3. Half sleeves pin stripe blue shirt (with school mono on the sleeves and without pocket) for girls.
4. Grey ankle socks and black sneakers.

### SPORTS UNIFORM ( SAME FOR BOYS AND GIRLS )

1. Light blue, navy blue and white sublimation print T-shirt with collar.
2. Navy blue dry fit lower with light blue piping on the sides.
3. Grey ankle socks and black sneakers.

### TIPS FOR STUDENTS

1. **Pack your bag** according to the **time-table** the **previous night**, before coming to the school.
2. Shoes to be **brushed** and uniform to be **ironed** and hung the **previous night**.
3. **Be regular** in your **work** and submit the **subject note book** promptly for **correction**.

1. Parents to check the condition of **summer uniform** and get a new one, if required. Please ensure that your **child comes in proper summer uniform** from **new session**.
2. Fill up the **"My Page"** along with latest Passport size photograph in school uniform, sign and submit it.

4. Send your child to school with **nourishing, wholesome food**.
5. Ensure that your child reaches **five minutes** before the given time at the **bus stop**.
6. **Converse** with your child **in English** as far as possible.
7. **Summer Break** :- **01<sup>st</sup> May 2025 to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2025** for classes IX to XII. **School will reopen** on 01<sup>st</sup> July 2025.
