


Eligibility Criteria for Contesting Election –

- Studied 3 – 4 years in school.
- Academics – ● Above 85% for classes VII and VIII
 - 'A⁺' Grade (In all the subjects in class V) for Nomination of students for class VI.
- Co-curricular Activities – Participation atleast in one School Competition / Inter School Competition– Cultural Literary / Sports (Internal / External).
- Regularity & Punctuality – Attendance 75%.
- **General Personality** – Spoken English, Behaviour, Obedience, Cooperation towards classmates, teachers and school in general.
- New students are not allowed to contest the election as they need to understand the school system.
- Students who have been elected as a member of Students' Council once are not allowed to contest the election again. This will provide equal opportunity to all the students.
